Top Bash 96 prize is computer, monitor

A Dell Dimension Pentium-based desktop computer with color monitor will be the grand prize for the Westfield Project Graduation - BASH '96, the all-night substance-free party for Westfield High School seniors on their graduation night.

"The money for the computer, a \$1,500 value that will be awarded at the breakfast at the end of BASH, came from donations by the Westfield Service League (\$1,000) and the Optimist Club," said project chairman A. Donald Pray.

The Optimist Club was one of the founding co-sponsors of Project Graduation in Westfield along with the Westfield High School Parent-

Teacher Organization and the Westfield Recreation Department.

"This is the seventh year for Westfield's graduation party and we are delighted to again have a computer as the grand prize; an ideal gift for a college-bound graduate," said Mr. Pray.

More than 230 seniors have already signed up for BASH '96 and it is anticipated that more than 90 percent of this year's 305 graduating seniors will attend the event.

Graduation will occur Tuesday, June 25, and the party will take place after graduation from 10 p.m.-6 a.m. at Ricochet Racquet in South Plainfield. The theme for this year's party is "Winnie the Pooh."
